BIRD, George W.

Birth: 13 October 1823, Elmira, Chemung, New York
Married: Eliza Curtiss, 7 September 1845
Death: 1 July 1917, Lamoni, Decatur, Iowa

George W. Bird joined The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and moved to Nauvoo, Hancock, Illinois, to be with the Saints. He helped bring lumber from Wisconsin to help build the Nauvoo House and the Nauvoo Temple. After the death of Joseph Smith he affiliated with Lyman Wight and settled in Texas.

George was baptized a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints on 7 October 1860 at Galland's Grove, Shelby, Iowa, by J. A. McIntosh. He was confirmed by U. Roundy and W. Vanausdell. He was ordained an elder on 12 March 1864 in Galland's Grove by T. Dobson, U. Roundy, and J. A. McIntosh. He attended the Pleasanton and Lamoni, Iowa branches; the Hope, Missouri Branch; and the Pleasant View, Kansas Branch.
