Rolfe states: "John Rolfe (2.3), son of Henry Rolfe (1.1), was born about 1634 in England, probably at Whiteparish, Wiltshire Co. His birth date was recorded as 10 May 1634 at Cambridge, Mass. He married 4 Dec. 1656 at Newbury to Mary Scollard, dau. of Samuel and Rebecca (Kent) Scollard of Newbury, Mary was born 9 January 1641 England. It was after the birth of their 3rd. child and while John was away from Newbury that Mary became involved in a scandal with a Dr. Henry Greenland, a new-comer to Newbury. He was found guilty of adultery and ordered out of Newbury. He went first to Kittery, Maine from where he was forced to leave. He then relocated to Piscataway, New Jersey where he and his family settled. Shortly after John's return to Newbury, he, Mary and their dau. Mary & Rebecca relocated to Nantucket where their next five children were born. About 1672 the family relocated to a part of Cambridge that is now Arlington where he purchased and operated "Cook's Mill". Three, possibly four of their children were born there. John died 1 October 1681 at Newbury in the home of his brother, Benjamin. He had purchased land in Woodbridge, N.J. shortly prior to his death. It was shortly after his death that the family, with the exception of the dau., Rebecca, relocated to Woodbridge where they changed the spelling of their surname to Rolph."
