BIOGRAPHY: Noted in Hx if Cambridge: Probably came here with his mother when a minor. A cooper by trade. He was made a freeman, 2 June 1641 and became a member of the Artillery company in 1643. He is buried beside his first wife in "Cambridge burying-place". He gave to his daughters money (in pounds) to be distributed at their mom's death. To the sons was given land. Richard, the younger son of Elizabeth, very likely was a voyager in the ship with his mother when she emigrated about the year 1640. He was probably under twenty years of age at the time of his arrival, and unmarried. He was a cooper by trade. Richard became entitled to suffrage in the election of the colonial magistrates by his admission as freeman, June 2, 1641. The privilege was earnestly desired by every man, and all freeman at that period were required to be orthodox members of the church, twenty years old, and worth £200. The oath sworn at admission requires them to be true and faithful subjects of the Commonwealth, to yield assistance and support thereunto with persons and estate; maintain and preserve all her liberties 'and privileges; submit to her wholesome laws; never plot nor practice evil against her; nor consent to any that shall so do, but timely discover and reveal thee to lawful authorities. He became a member of the Artillery Company in 1643. This association, formed in 1637, met for improvement in discipline and tactics and comprised the leaders and officers of the volunteer trainbands, and the principal magistrates and citizens. Time first regularly organized company in America. 'It may be considered time germ from which. all our military character in New England, if not in the United States, has sprung': and exists still under the name of the Ancient and Honorable Artilleryge date found "Cutter Genealogy" film no# 0873033

RESEARCH: From "History of Cambridge, Massachusetts. 1630 -- 1877 with a Genealogical Register" by Lucius R. Paige. "William, s. of Elizabeth (1), about 1638, owned and occupied the estate at the S.W. corner of Dunster and Winthrop streets. He returned to England, and in 1653 resided at Newcastle-upon-Tyne; at which date he empowered Edward Goffe, Elijah Corlett [his brother in law], and Thomas Sweetman, of Camb., and Robert Hale of Chs. To collect debts due to him in New England. He probably d. without children; for Richard Cutter, by deed dated 10 June 1693 (six days previous to his own death), conveyed to his son William a house and lot in Camb. Describing the premises as "formerly the right and proper estate of William Cutter, my brother, deceased, and from him descended to me as my lawful right of inheritance."

BIOGRAPHY: William Cutter married Rebecca Rolfe, whose father, John Rolfe of Cambridge originally from Newbury, came hither about 1670 from Nantucket Island. William and wife were admitted to membership in Cambridge Church, 28 Jul, 1700, and the cherished relic, the family bible, bears marked evidence of frequent use. He was as heir of his father's estate and an executor of his will. A carpenter by profession, he was something of an husbandman, and dealt largely in real estate. In addition to these pursuits he appears to have added that of a miller, and carried on this business in mills erected on the banks of the stream near his house.

RESEARCH: "History of Cambridge, Massachusetts 1630--1877"p. 522 ,...."Mr. Cutter resided in Menotomy, not far from the present centre of Arlington. In 1685 he purchased of John Rolfe the mill formerly called 'Cook's Mill,' which long remained in his family, and is known as 'Cutter' Mill."
