RESEARCH: "... looking through records of early Woodbridge I found that church records of the Presbyterian church in Woodbridge had her [Mary Pike] death date of June 30, 1721, age 33. So, her date was correct. Then, Richard must have married twice.' [There were three children born after her death date.]In his will, made on Sept. 20, 1756, he mentioned his "well-beloved wife Mercy." Richard had married twice."

"On August 20, 1706 Richard married Mary Pike, born on November 9, 1687, daughter of aforementioned John Pike, one of the earliest and most active settlers in Woodbridge. Zebulon Pike, the discoverer of Pike's Peak in Colorado in 1806, was a descendant of a brother of Mary Pike Cutter.

BIOGRAPHY: William Cutter was known as Deacon William Cutter. He apparently was respected in Woodbridge as a good, God fearing man. He was the first son of Richard and Mary Pike Cutter. We are sure of this because of the dates regarding his birth and death. The records of Woodbridge are missing for the pertinent times of his marriage and the births of his children. Because of this we have to rely on secondary sources. I am sure that Mary is the daughter of the 3rd Stephen Kent, of the Kent family of Newbury, Essex, Massachusetts. There aren't available sources to prove this except that she names her first son Stephen. The Newbury records indicate that this Stephen Kent came to Woodbridge with the other settlers from Newbury. There is no death date for Mary Kent Cutter, nor her parents.

NOTE: Information gathered so far on Richard Cutter, son of Richard and Mary Pike Cutter. He was mentioned in his Father's will as being one of the executors. He married Elizabeth Foord (Ford) of Woodbridge, married 2nd Elizabeth Morris VanDeventer, and 3rd Charity--. Elizabeth Morris was the daughter of Robert and Ruth Morris, of Somerset County, New Jersey. She was the widow of Jacob Vandeventer, also of Somerset. She died in 1759 and is buried in Woodbridge. If there were any children born to Richard and Charity, they have not been located.
